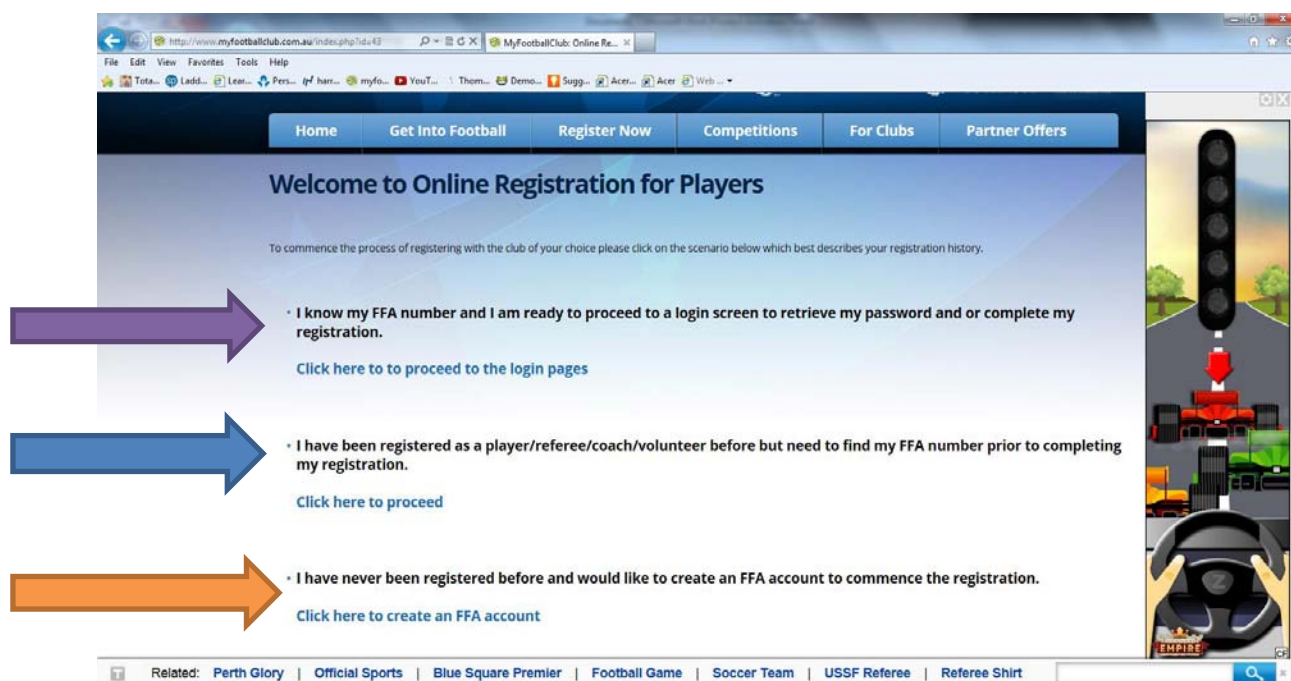


How to Online Register







Step 9 - You will need to choose the club you wish to register for (if you're a returning player, Bradbury will be the default entry and you will not have to do this step.)

Choose whether you wish to register as a player, coach or manager.

And then choose the package you wish to register for. The packages that appear will depend on your age or the age of your child as it will not allow you to apply for a team outside the restricted age brackets. For example, a 9 year old will be unable to play up to U12s and can only play 2 levels above their age group. Only U9, U10 & U11 will appear. Add package and then click next.
